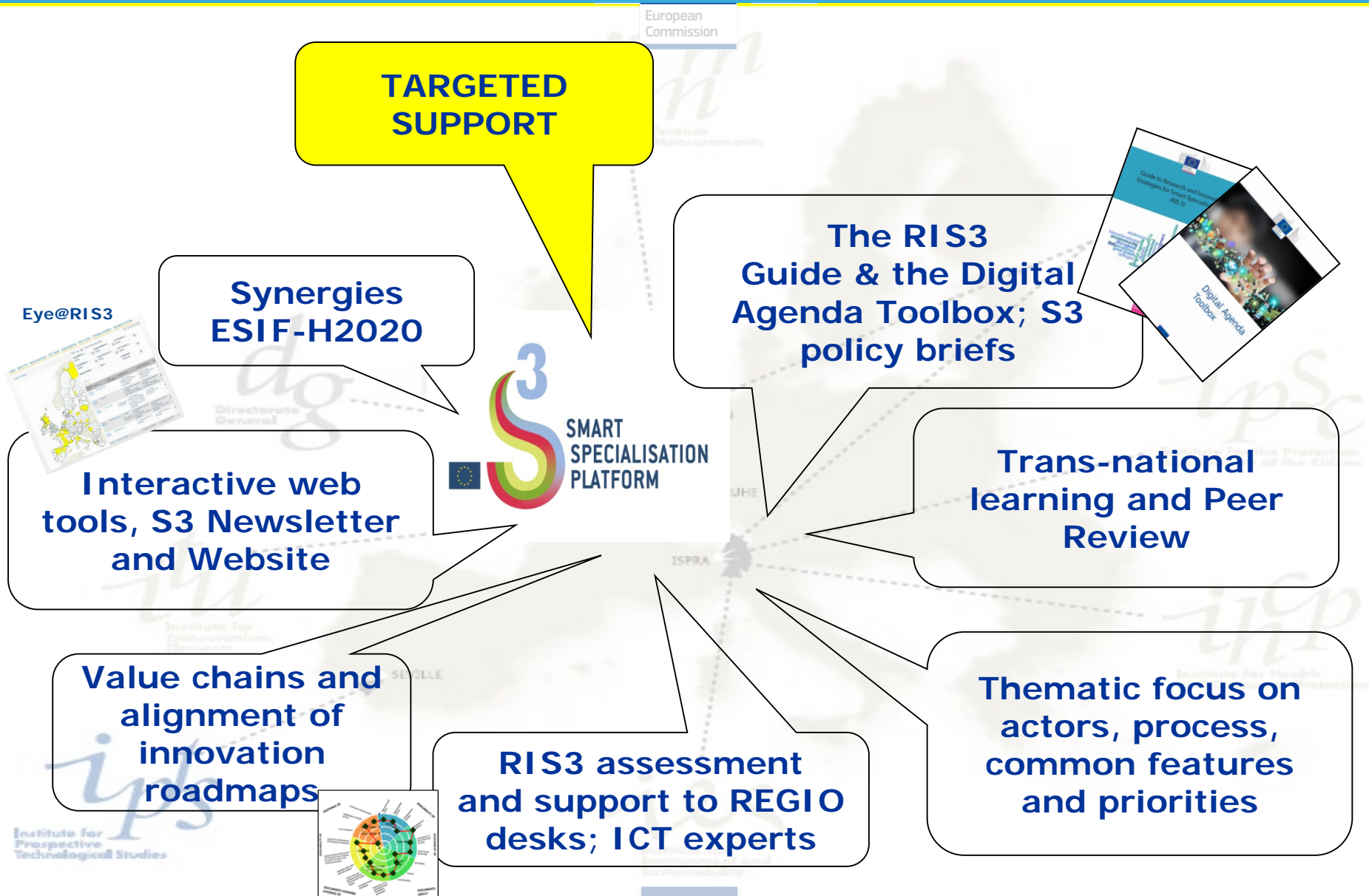

To serve as a test-bed for theories on Smart Specialisation – understanding of RIS3

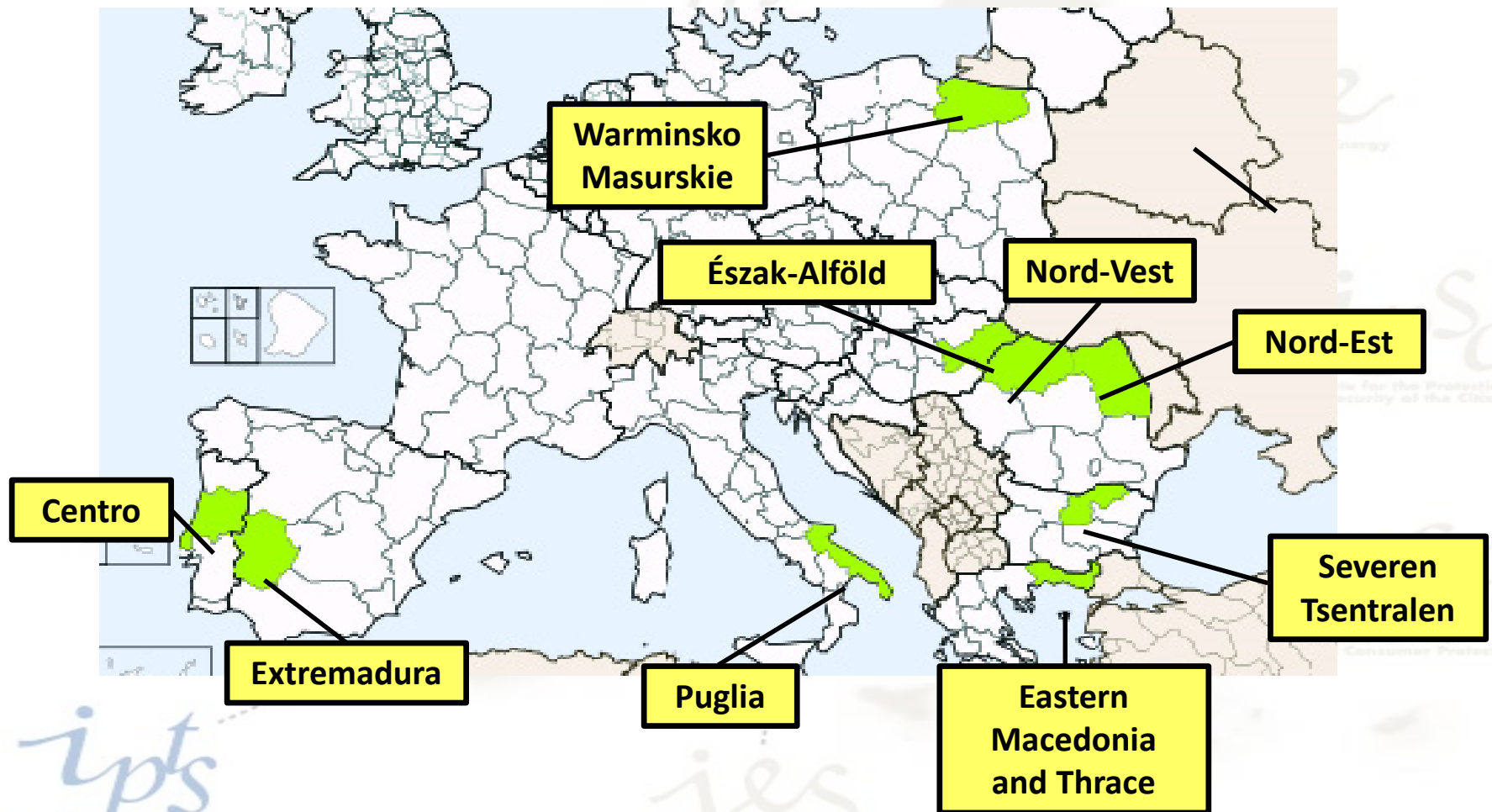
Background

Support to RIS3 implementation in Lagging Regions

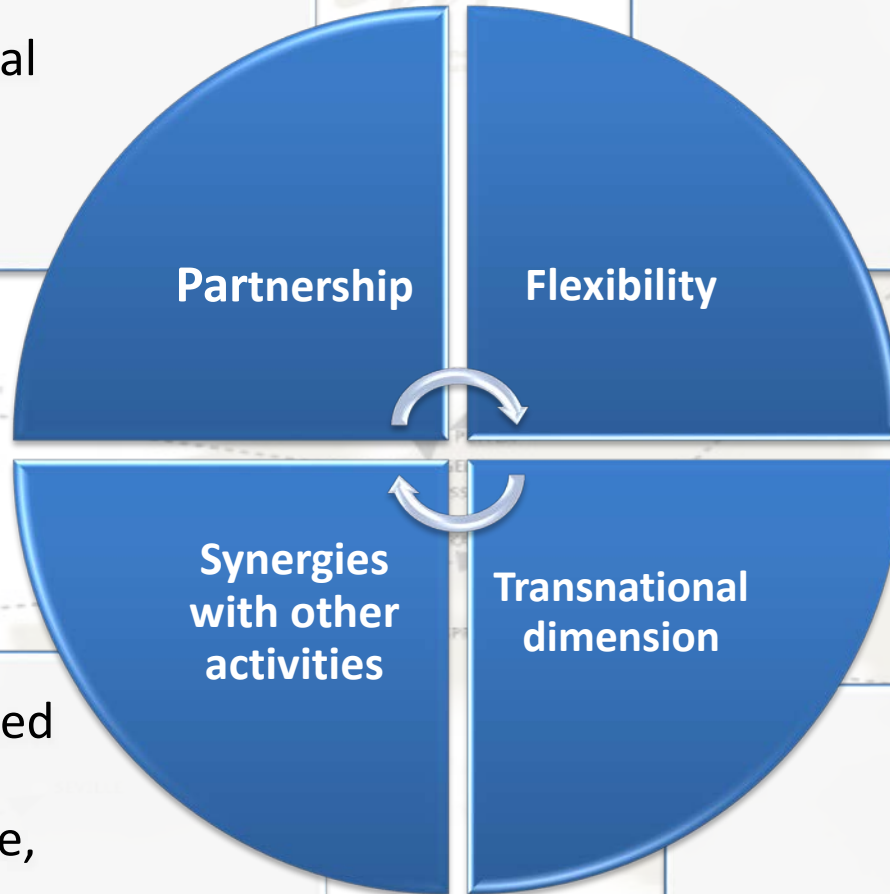
Focused on 9 regions in Eastern and Southern Europe: selection of regions

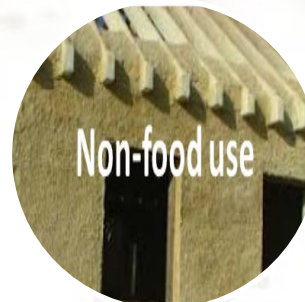

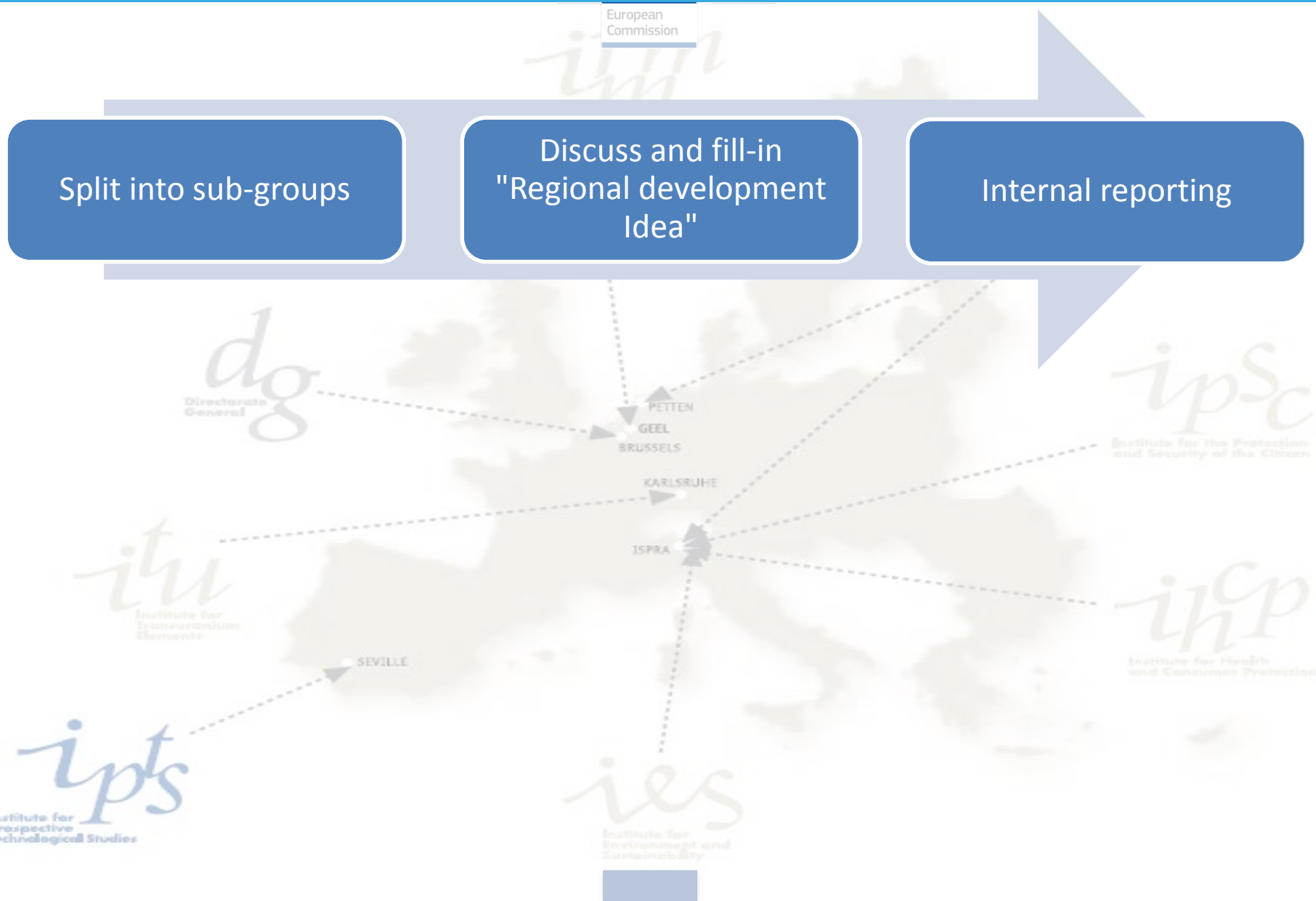
